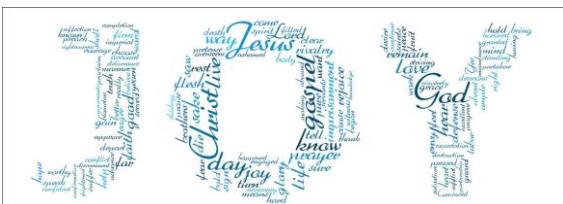
Epiphany
