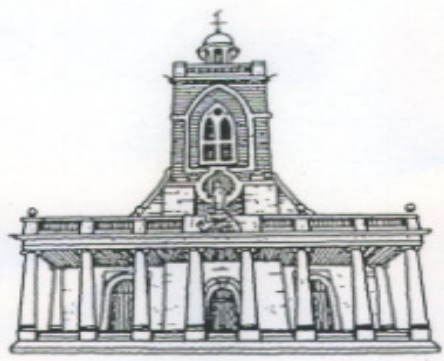

<b>Summary of PPG Spending 2012/13</b>	
<p><b>Objectives in spending:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>To enable every child to be able to access a full range of educational opportunities within the curriculum as well as extra curricular experiences.</li> <li>To develop individual and group intervention programmes to enable all pupils to make good progress.</li> </ul>	
<p><b>Summary of spending actions:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Part funding of an additional teacher in a specific year group where a large number of vulnerable pupils were grouped for Maths and English support.</li> <li>Funding of classroom support to enable small group support sessions.</li> <li>Equipment to support learning.</li> <li>Funding for vulnerable pupils to attend after school clubs.</li> <li>Part funding for vulnerable pupils to take part in school trips across the school..</li> <li>Part funding to enable vulnerable pupils to take part in the Northamptonshire 'Brass Project'</li> <li>Funding for a teacher taking higher ability children in writing, once a week in Year 2</li> </ul>	
<p><b>Outcomes to date:</b></p> <p>Progress of those pupils eligible for the Pupil Premium 2012/ 2013: (Average Point Score)</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>During Year 2 children made 'good' progress in Reading 6.5, Writing 8.0 and Maths 6.3</li> <li>During Year 6 children made 'good' progress in Reading 4.8 and Writing 4.5 and 5.1 Maths.</li> </ul> <p><b>Additional Outcomes:</b></p> <p>Although it is always positive to see 'good' in year progress in English and maths, our disadvantaged pupils also benefit from the Pupil Premium in ways that are not as easily measured. The support and financing we have been able to put in place has gone a long way to improve accessibility to all aspects of education and improved levels of self esteem amongst a large majority of the pupils.</p>
